

Options for High Holy Day Services

This year, M'kor Shalom is offering 3 options for attending each High Holy Day service. For each service, you may choose to:

1. Use your tickets to enter the building and sit in the Sanctuary.

- No advance registration required.
- Bring your tickets to the service.
- Wear a mask (required at all times indoors).
- Vaccinations will be required for all persons attending in-person services in our sanctuary.

2. Use your tickets to enter the tent *(details below)* in our parking lot; watch the service on a large screen.

- Advance registration required.
- Bring your tickets to the tent.
- Masks are required in the tent.

3. Participate in the service on Zoom.

- Advance registration required.
- No tickets required, but you must be a member in good standing.
- Whether you wear a mask on Zoom is up to you!



Tell Me About The Tent...

Since this is the first year M'kor Shalom is offering you the option to sit outside under a tent, you may have a few questions.

Here are some facts about the tent:

- The tent is a large, 2-sided tent, rented from a local party supplier.
- It will be set up in the side parking lot, next to the school.
- Services will be streamed live from the Sanctuary to a large screen inside the tent.
- There will be prayerbooks available in the tent.
- Those in the tent will have access to bathrooms inside the building.
- Masks are mandatory for those sitting under the tent.
- There will be ushers and security in and around the tent.

The tent is an available option for all High Holy Day services listed on your ticket, except Selichot, Erev Rosh Hashanah, Rosh Hashanah & Yom Kippur Early Services, and the Tot Family Service.

If you are interested in sitting under the tent for services, you must:

- Have your ticket with you, just as you would for entering the sanctuary.
- Pre-register for each service you would like to attend in the tent.
