Do you or a family member require any special accommodations during the High Holy Days to help you more fully participate in services?

We offer the following for congregants requesting special accommodations for Services:

SERVICES OFFERED THREE WAYS: This year, due to Covid recommendations, we are offering you three options for services, and all options require this form to be completed with your specific requests:

- Services in the Sanctuary fully masked
- Services in a large, two-sided Tent located in our parking lot; Chairs in place for your comfort, services presented on a large screen live, masks not required
- Zoom Services from your home

Special accommodation arrangements include:

- Early entry into the Main entrance or Tent seating (you will receive a special Pass that will be sent to you separately from your High Holy Day ticket)
- Prayer Book to use at home so you can follow services. These can then be picked up in the main office prior to the High Holy Days

We ask that you complete this form indicating your Special Accommodation request and return it to the main synagogue office by Monday, August 23.
